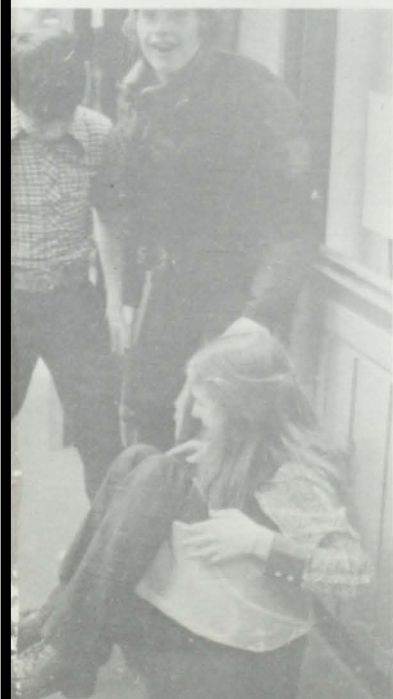
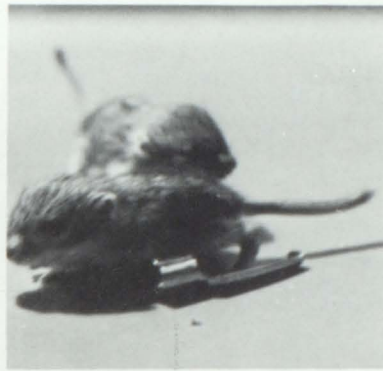


## Senior Will
