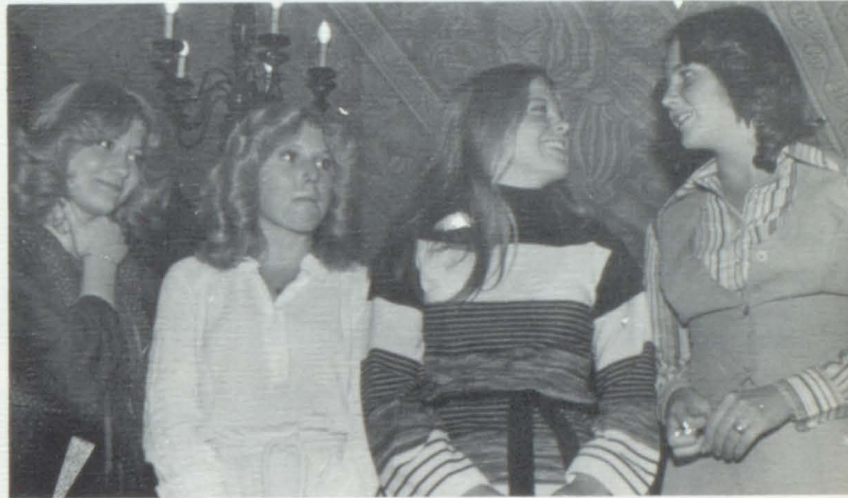

# Cross Country

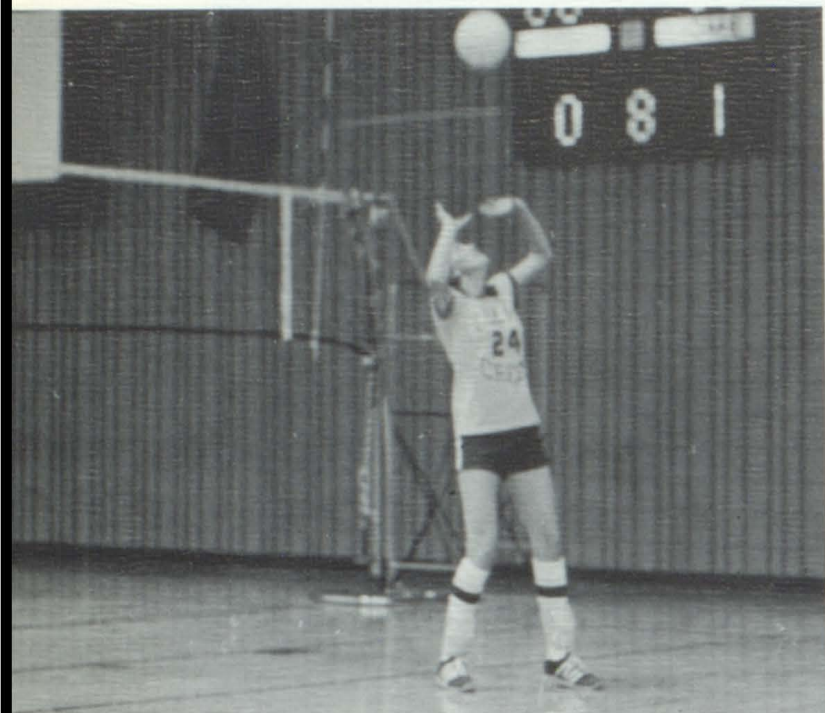
